Austin, TX

▪ **Generational Rim Protector with Elite Switchability**

- **Blocks** – 4.9 Blocks/40, 7.3 Blocks/100, 13.2% Block % (3rd-highest all-time – Anthony Davis = 13.7%)
- **Rebounding** – 28.2% Def/Reb (#1 high major in country), 20.8 Reb/100 (#1 in country)
3.2 OReb per game, 1.34 points per possession, scored on 70% of OReb
- **Switchability** – routinely switched onto guards and wings, forcing action away from the lane, creating turnovers or difficult, inefficient shot opportunities for opponents

▪ **Excellent Finisher**

- **Receiving end of a cut** – 1.5 points per possession, scoring 34 out of 41 times in this situation
- **Transition** – 1.16 points per possession on rim running – run the floor well (and often)

▪ **Knockdown shooter from NBA distance and the free throw line**

- Shot 35.4% from 3PT and 71.4% on free throws in NCAA conference play
- Streamlined shot mechanics in offseason to produce a quicker release and a steeper descent angle where the ball lands softly with a forgiving bounce
- Routinely making 35 to 40 NBA threes out of 50 in practice

▪ **IQ and Maturity**

- 2nd lowest turnover rate (12.7%) in peer group
- Only 3.2 fouls per 40 minutes (3rd lowest in peer group)
- Elite defensive instincts, ability to time jumps
